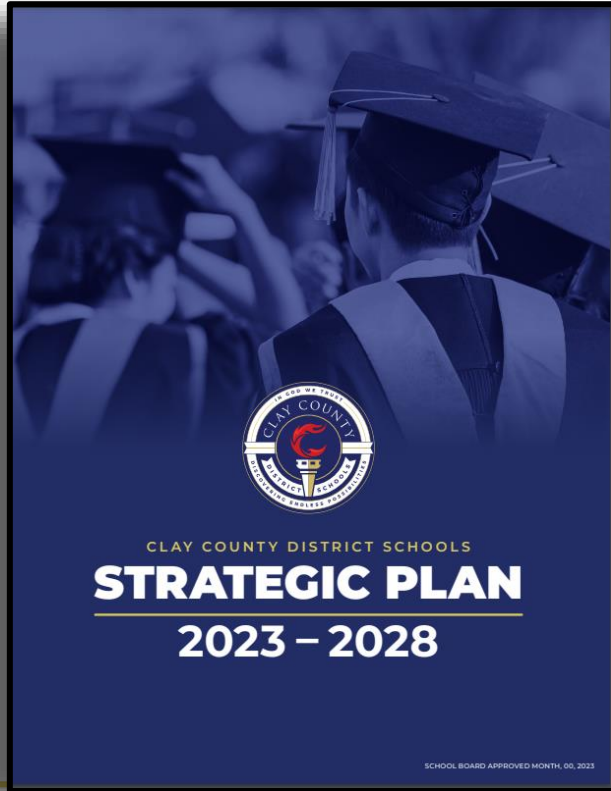

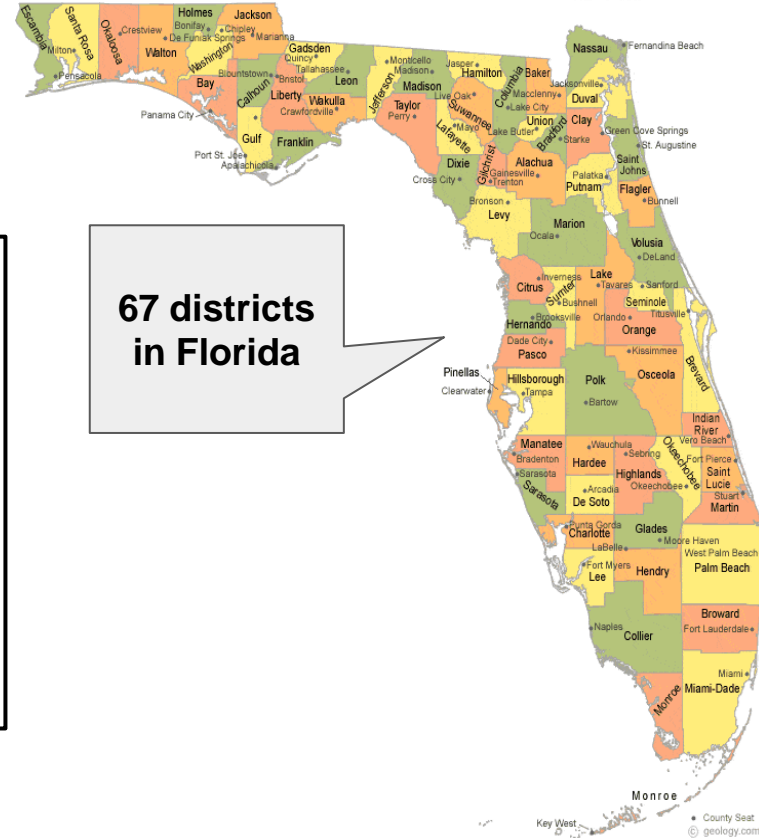

- ★ 12th in ELA



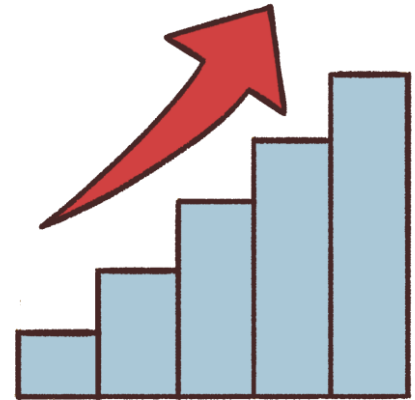


School Grades

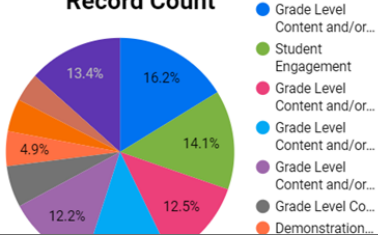

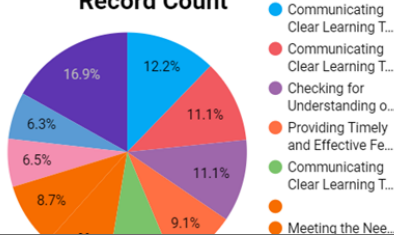

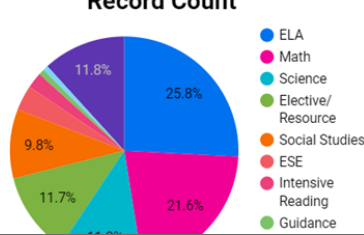
Four Principles Record Count



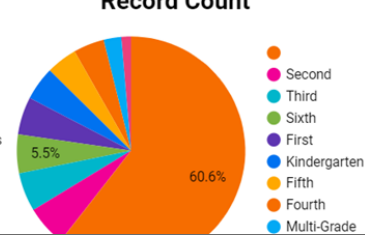
Instructional Elements Record Count
