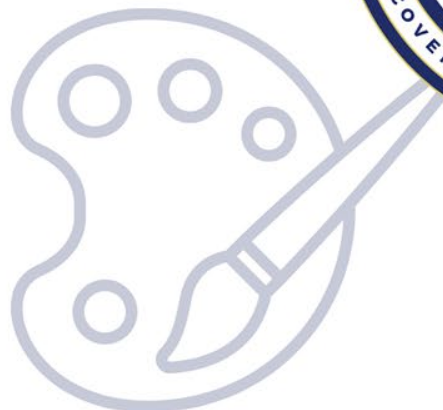


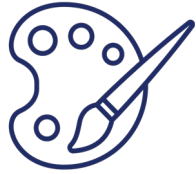

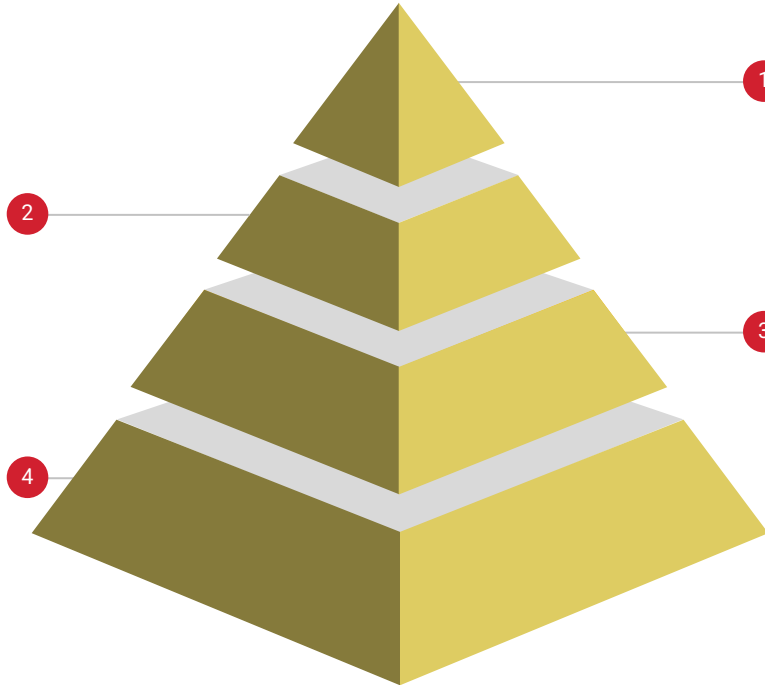
Fine Arts Curriculum and Assessment

Assessment and Performance

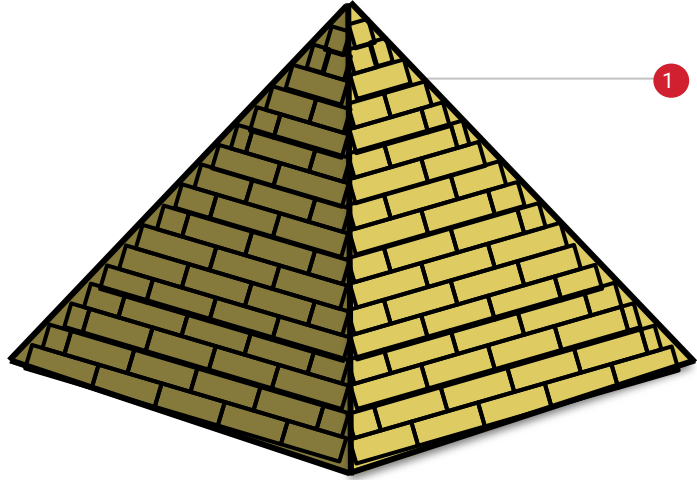
The fine arts offer unique opportunities to assess individual and group performance. Skills and benchmarks are assessed in addition to content, medium, literature selections, etc...
