



## 2022 - 2023 HIGHLIGHTS

Thank you for you making a difference in the health and well-being of your school community.

- Approximately 18,000 families received heart healthy information.
- 27 schools participating.
- 1,794 students took a heart healthy challenge.
- 275 students completed Finn's Mission.
- \$128,769 raised to fuel the American Heart Association's mission.

- \$9,530 in school givebacks awards to schools in P.E./wellness equipment and/or direct contributions to schools.
- 25 active research grants funded in Florida.



## IN YOUR COMMUNITY

57 families have identified that their child or sibling(s) have been personally impacted by heart disease or stroke.

We estimate that there are even more students personally impacted that have not been given the opportunity to participate in our programs.



### THE NEED

We know safety is a top concern for you. Our vision is to provide life-saving skills that your whole school community can benefit from.

- Last year, in Clay County, students and families who participated in our programs learned the following skills:
  - 422 families learned Hands-Only CPR® through Finn's Mission.
  - 394 families learned the warning signs of a stroke and dangers of vaping
  - However, we know there is still a gap of approximately 17,000 families in our county who 4 need these life-saving skills.
