## NEW:

## SAFETY AND SECURITY COORDINATOR

Numerous school safety projects (Access Control Projects at all schools, Panic Buttons, Camera Systems, Digital Inventory, Weather Systems, etc) have been initiated and will need management, evaluation, and adjustments. We must be responsive to each program to ensure successful implementation and the overall safety of CCDS students and staff. For example, with our badge access programs alone, each school will need to inventory/assign hundreds of badges that will act as passes to allow student movement throughout building doors. This will allow us to eliminate exemptions (under HB1473), but we must provide district support for such programs or we risk causing security issues as badges go missing and are not turned-off and replaced in a timely manner. Programs will be well managed and efficient for schools to use. This position will be responsive to addressing any issues or needs that arise to ensure the schools are safe with all their safety resources up and running.

## **REVISED:**

## **COORDINATOR OF SHOP OPERATIONS**

This position has been revised to enhance customer service within our shop department and help meet district-wide needs, particularly for the white fleet. The role will also ensure that required safety measures are followed by implementing accountability practices within the shop.

#### Job Description:

Coordinate the district's strategic safety initiatives by leading the implementation and maintenance of related school safety projects. Facilitates professional development for teachers, staff, and school leaders on how to most effectively implement safety technology and procedures. Ensures access control projects are efficient and that badge access security remains responsive and a daily priority. The position involves collaboration with project managers and supervisors to facilitate timely and effective system rollouts. Gather and analyze school safety data to review safety initiatives at each school and ensure current practices and procedures are effective in protecting students and staff. Serves as a member of the Director of Safety and Security's staff.

#### Responsibilities and Duties of this Position Include:

- Coordinates, oversees, and reviews the implementation of safety-related projects in schools. Position will support and assist end users of multiple safety projects, including but not limited to: badge access control systems, visitor management systems, camera surveillance systems, mobile panic alert systems (Alyssa's Alert), weather notification systems, key management products and services and/or other safety-related technologies/equipment to ensure proficiency.
- 2. Coordinates and manages access control projects with school leaders to ensure lost/stolen badges are turned off and new badges created/programmed in a timely manner. Will also collaborate with school leaders to ensure access control door timers coordinate with bell schedule changes.
- 3. <u>Maintain accurate records of badge/key holders, access levels, and system maintenance crucial for audits and security management.</u>
- 4. <u>Coordinates project performance review process in schools to determine product effectiveness and collaborates with stakeholders to improve product performance.</u>
- 5. Collaborates with facility project managers to ensure school comfort/readiness upon project completion.
- 6. <u>Conducts/leads professional development with school leaders and staff in regards to the proper usage of safety technology (i.e. Audio Enhancement/EPIC, PerryWeather, MyTag, RAPTOR, Avigilon, Genetec/Access Control, etc).</u>
- 7. Assists with the planning and development of CCDS processes and procedures for proper usage of new safety equipment/technology.
- 8. <u>Attends professional development to stay abreast of educational safety trends and advances in the fields of safety technology.</u>
- 9. <u>Coordinates annual school safety walks to identify safety and security vulnerabilities and analyzes/implements recommendations provided by first responders.</u>
- 10. <u>Communicates with internal and external stakeholders to enhance understanding of school needs, and district initiatives and priorities related to schools.</u>
- 11. <u>Actively monitors and analyzes school safety data (SESIR, safety infractions, internal audits, FSSAT, etc) on</u> a guarterly basis for trends and creates action plans for overall district safety improvements.
- 12. Regularly reviews Florida Statute as it relates to school safety and ensures district policies and procedures are meeting state and federal mandates and best practices.
- 13. Provide a high level of customer service to school based administrators, teachers, staff, and the public.
- 14. <u>Keeps Director of Safety and Security and Assistant Superintendent of Operations informed of school</u> matters, as well as other potential problems or unusual events, through appropriate channels and responds to constituent issues on behalf of the Superintendent.
- 15. <u>Performs other duties as assigned by the Superintendent, Assistant Superintendent of Operations, and/or the Director of Safety and Security.</u>

#### **Required Qualifications:**

- 1. Experience with educational safety products/services, i.e., badge access control systems, visitor management systems, camera surveillance systems, mobile panic alert systems (Alyssa's Alert), weather notification systems, and key management products and services.
- 2. Bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university OR Associates degree with a minimum of three (3) years of experience in the field of Safety and Security OR ten (10) years of experience in the field of Safety and Security.
- 3. Become a certified School Safety Specialist within one year of being hired.
- 4. Working knowledge of State of Florida policies, rules, regulations, and statutes which govern school police and safe school operations.
- 5. Working knowledge of best practices in school security.
- 6. Strong word processing, spreadsheet, and database software skills,
- 7. Strong creative problem-solving skills.
- 8. Strong time management skills.
- 9. Strong presentation skills.
- 10. Must have a valid Florida Driver's License and maintain a safe driving record during employment.
- 11. Ability to manage multiple tasks, set priorities, meet deadlines, and schedules, deal with frequent interruptions, and work as part of a team.

#### **Job Description:**

Supervises the District's Transportation Shop facilities to ensure the maintenance of District vehicles. The Coordinator of Shop Operations is responsible to the Director of Transportation.

#### Responsibilities and duties of this position include:

- 1. Assume overall supervisor/management responsibilities for the District's vehicle maintenance program.
- 2. Supervise all shop personnel. involved in vehicle maintenance and assist with employee performance evaluations. to include evaluations, planning, developing, and managing shop personnel schedules.
- 3. <u>Manage and oversee the day-to-day operations of the fleet services, record keeping, and preparation of detailed reports for the district's review.</u>
  - Coordinate the collection and input of vehicle maintenance data through automated programs, and prepare routine reports for the District's review.
- 4. Recommend the procurement/replacement of vehicles in use throughout the District.
- 5. <u>Implement preventive maintenance protocols, vehicle maintenance protocols, and inspection protocols for all vehicles district-wide. Develop and maintain a bus inspection schedule to meet current state standards.</u>
  - Schedule personnel/equipment within the realm of fleet maintenance to assure vehicle inspections in accordance with statutory requirements and Board Policy.
- 6. Coordinate the appropriate rotation of buses to ensure maximum efficiency/life of each vehicle.

  Coordinate vehicle and shop related purchases from Departmental funds and interact as appropriate with District Purchasing.
- 7. <u>Manage budget/purchasing for all of the shop operations. Assist with vendor procurement, assigning/maintaining contracts, and bid specifications for needed items.</u>
  - Coordinate the assignment of buses to drivers and the rotation of buses as appropriate to maximize longevity and efficiency of bus fleet.
- 8. Oversee our county-wide fuel program. Oversee inspections of fuel storage, fuel leak detection, and delivery systems.
- 9. Monitor security of the garage shop and District transportation vehicles.
- 10. Work in conjunction with the Transportation Supervisors in recommending guidelines and policies for transportation services.
  - Coordinate with the Operations Supervisor in recommending guidelines and policies for transportation services.
- 11. Assist in the investigation of all school bus accidents.
- 12. Coordinate after-hour breakdowns.
- 13. Perform other duties as assigned by the Director.
