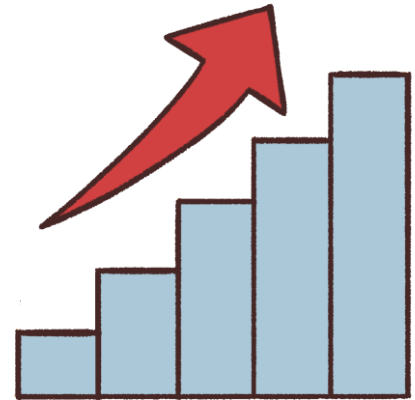

- 93% of Clay County Schools earned an A or B
- MHS became an A school for the first time since 2011
- OHS and RHS (+ 24 points)-both A schools
- KHHS- A school 31 point increase!
- GCJ and LAJ- A schools
- SLE- A school, 19 point increase
- MRE- A school
- CGE- went up a letter grade

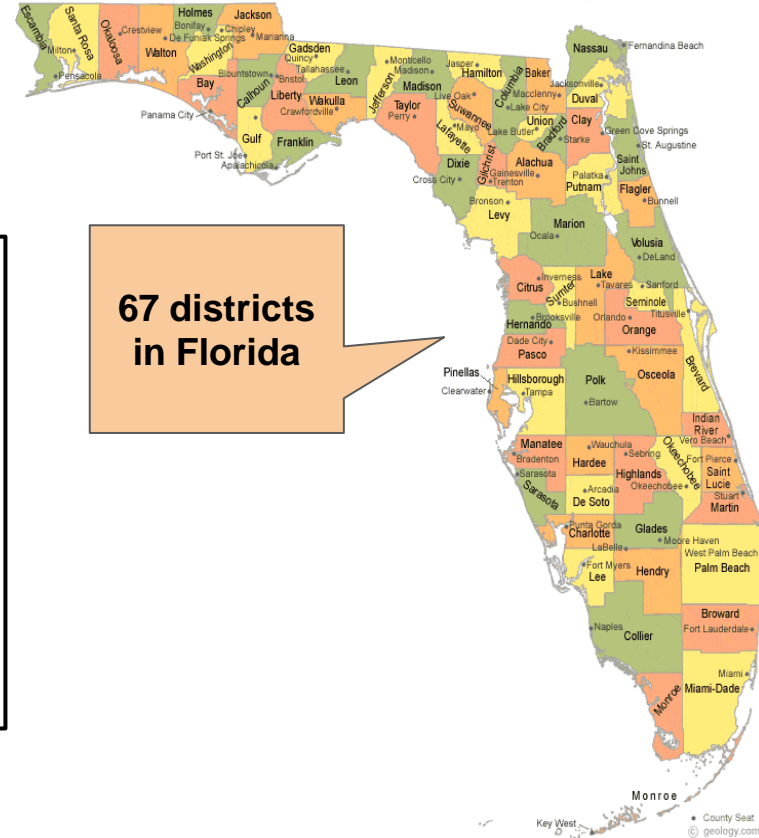
Orange Park Elementary is #19 elementary school in Florida of 4,212 in Florida

- ★ 12th in ELA





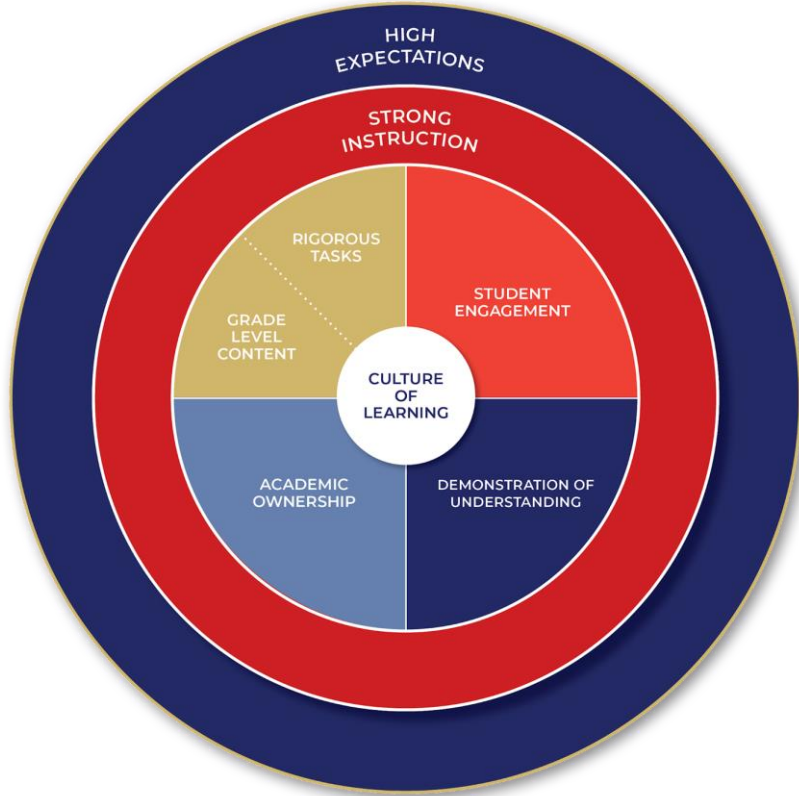

Accelerated Programs for Rising 7th and 9th

- **January**: Invitations to apply are sent to qualifying 6th and 8th grade students
- **January and February**: Schools hold informational parent meetings
- **February-March** Deadlines to apply for programs (applications will be available on school websites)
- **March**: Acceptance emails are sent for students to accept seats

Controlled Open Enrollment

- Controlled Open Enrollment (COE) provides parents and legal guardians of children and youth entering grades K-12 the opportunity to seek enrollment in a school other than the zoned school of attendance.
- In accordance with Florida Statute 1002.31, parents/legal guardians currently residing in any school district in the State of Florida may select schools from a list identified by the Clay County School District as having available seats based upon published guidelines.





Current Open Schools



- These schools have at least one open seat in one grade level
- Visit OneClay website to see availability by grade level and to apply for enrollment



Application for 2024-2025 School Year

- The district will update and publish the list of schools with open seats for the 24-25 school year on **May 30**
- Application will be posted on the website
- Once an application for an available seat is received, and space is available, registration information will be sent to the parent through the email provided. Parents have a two week window to complete registration. After two weeks, incomplete registrations will be put on the waitlist.
