





Step #1 Acquire Your Student's 6-digit Family Portal Access Code








Code will be a mix of letters and numbers



• Two-Way Communication:

- It facilitates direct communication between parents and teachers, allowing for easy messaging and interaction.
- It also enables students to communicate directly with their teachers in a monitored and safe environment.

• Classroom Management:

- Rooms helps teachers share materials, and provide updates to students and parents.
- Features like "Class Stream" allow teachers to post announcements and assignments, keeping everyone informed.

Centralized Communication:

- The platform aims to consolidate communication, eliminating the need for various separate channels.
- This helps ensure that everyone is on the same page and that important information is easily accessible.
