- Approximately 500-600 attendees

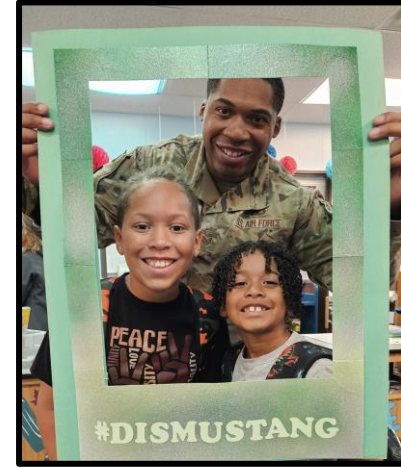
