




District Accreditation



Accreditation

- District Accreditation is a quality assurance process that uses a qualified outside agency to determine that an educational organization has maintained a certain level of educational standards.
- The accreditation process asks institutions and systems to critically evaluate their vision, strategies, priorities, leadership, programs, and resources.







Why Does Accreditation Matter?

Students

Students benefit from their district's commitment to raising student achievement.

Students that attend an accredited institution gain greater access to federal loans, scholarships, postsecondary education and military programs.

Parents

Accreditation assures parents that their child's school is meeting nationally accepted standards for quality and successful professional practices.

Teachers

Through the accreditation process, teachers and staff engage in a critical evaluation of teaching and learning practices. This evaluation fosters a culture of continuous improvement and a focus on achieving academic excellence.
