- 3. The student must be enrolled in a grade level that receives Title I, Part A services in the receiving district.
- 4. The student must meet the criteria for Title I services established by the receiving district.

- 1. The District Title I office of <u>both</u> districts shall assist as needed in establishing a means of communication between the participating non-public schools and the parents or guardians of students receiving services.
- 2. The <u>receiving district</u> shall ensure that each student receiving Title I, Part A services receives services equitable to those received by other comparable students in the same grade level at the same school.
- 3. The <u>receiving district</u> shall ensure that each student receiving services is assessed in accordance with the applicable state and federal requirements using the assessment instruments and assessment dates in place for other students enrolled in the non-public school Title I program.
- 4. The <u>receiving district</u> shall absorb the cost of providing Title I, Part A services to each student it receives from the sending district. The <u>sending district</u> shall supply all information necessary for the <u>receiving district</u> to determine the amount of its Title I, Part per-pupil allocation to the non-public school in which the student is enrolled.
- 5. <u>Each district</u> shall inform the other district in writing of any changes in status or circumstances which affect the provision of services to any participating student. These shall include, but not be limited to, a change in the student's residency or guardianship, a change in the Title I status of the non-public school, or a change in the attendance areas of the <u>sending</u> district.
