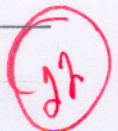

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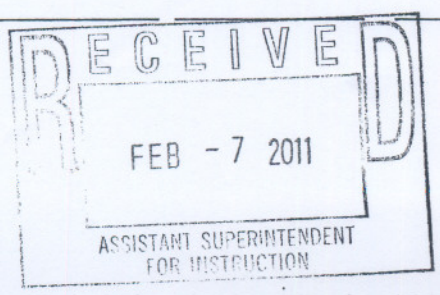

SC.G.1.2.5


Student knows that animals eat plants or other animals to acquire the energy they need for survival.
