Victim CLAY COUNTY SCHOOL BOARD	Offense DEAL IN STOLEN PROPERTY
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On 01-03-08 at around 1200hrs, I made contact with the Defendant, [REDACTED], during a traffic stop for not using a turn signal when making a right hand turn and no seat belt (secondary) in FL- X05WUN he was solely operating.

Upon contact with the Defendant, I noted a strong odor of Cannabis coming from the Defendants persons/interior of the vehicle. I advised the Defendant of my detection and further instructed him to step out of the vehicle, where he was further detained and advised Miranda.

The Defendant post Miranda advised me that he had just come from a friends house [REDACTED] "smoked out in a small room" and was the reasoning I smelled marijuana on his clothes. The Defendant further advised that there was no marijuana inside the vehicle, that he smoked it all.

During my probable cause search of the Defendants vehicle, I noted a Dell laptop computer behind the drivers seat with CCSB #78349 (Clay County School Board) written on the reverse. I asked the Defendant who it belong to, to which he advised it was his wife [REDACTED]

I asked the Defendant if his wife worked for the Clay County School Board, to which he advised me that he had initially lied to me and advised me the following:

The Defendant stated that on 12-24-07 at around 1400hrs, he was behind his mothers home [REDACTED] The Defendant further stated that he observed an unknown teenage black male walk in and out of a portable classroom at W.E Cherry Elementary School. The Defendant stated that he yelled at the teenager and further summoned him to come over to him at the fence that separates his mothers house from the school.

The Defendant stated that the black male Identified himself as [REDACTED] and further begged him (DEF) not to call the police. The Defendant stated that [REDACTED] gave him an open invitation to go to the Cedar Bend area, and "smoke out" in return for his cooperation of not calling the police. The Defendant stated that [REDACTED] left the area on his bike and had one DVD player, and some DVD's on his persons.

The Defendant advised that he then went to the front of his house, when [REDACTED] rode up on his bike and gave him a dell laptop computer that he had hidden underneath his shirt.

The Defendant stated that he knew the computer was stolen, and that it was wrong, but took the computer and placed it in his Jeep behind the drivers seat, where I found it today. The Defendant stated that he intended to sell the computer at a later time for money.

The Defendant completed a sworn written statement to the effect of his verbal confession.

I made contact with W.E Cherry Teacher/involved other, L. Cebulskie, who confirmed the lap top and other items as being school property.

Cebulski also took possession of the undamaged property that I recovered, further signing a release.

**NARRATIVE CONTINUATION**

On the listed date and time, I was dispatched to 23 S. Green Avenue in reference to a report of a Burglary. Upon arrival, I made contact with the reporting persons, Mrs. Kelly Wigg and Mrs. Vikkie Padgett. Mrs. Wigg stated she opened the building at 6:00 A.M. on the listed date. Upon entry of the building, both females noticed a window on the east side of the building was open. Both females exited the building to locate help.

I met with the Supervisor of Instructional Support, Mrs. Alisa Jones. Mrs. Jones showed me the plaques that were on her wall. Both plaques had wooden mallets on them which were broken. One mallet was broken off completely and the other plaque only had the head of the mallet left on it, the handle was missing. I was unable to locate the wooden mallet or the handle. Mrs. Jones stated she did not know if anything was missing except for some candy. I told Mrs. Jones to contact me if she were to notice any other items missing or damaged.

I spoke with Mrs. Joyce Padgett, Press Operator Supervisor. Mrs. Padgett stated the drawer of her desk had been broken off. She stated the drawer was locked. Mrs. Padgett stated she did not think anything was missing from her desk.

The point of entry was a window on the east side of the building. The window was not damaged it appeared that the window was just pulled out. The interior of the building was at a disarray with candy and office supplies scattered about. There were numerous computers and laptops inside the building that were not touched. Officer Chaney searched the area for physical evidence and dusted for latent finger prints with negative results.

I was later dispatched back to the listed address in reference to a report of a broken window. Upon arrival, I noticed a window was broken on the west side of the building. I searched the area for physical evidence with negative results. It appeared that the window had been broken from the outside of the building due to the indention on the remaining glass in the window frame. The majority of the glass was on the floor inside the building just under the window but there was also some glass on the ground outside under the window. The glass that was on the ground appeared that it had been on the ground for several days due to rain splatter on the glass and dirt build up around the glass.

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On 01/10/08 I responded to 2851 Sandridge Road, in reference to a report of a stolen golf cart.

Upon my arrival, I met with Mrs. Deborah Fish (teacher), who stated on 01/07/08 at approximately 1600 hours she unlocked the door to the shed where the golf cart and athletic equipment is kept and noticed the golf cart was missing. She stated the door was locked and the other item taken was a field drag, which is an item pulled behind the golf cart. The last time the golf cart was used was by Mr. Stephen Turner (teacher) on 12/23/07. Mr. Turner stated he locked the golf cart up in the shed at approximately 1600 on that day. Mr. Turner advised they have looked all over the school campus and the elementary school next door and have not been able to locate the golf cart. He also advised they checked with maintenance to see if anyone had used the golf cart, which met with negative results. Mr. Turner advised many people have a key to the shed. Mr. Turner and Mrs. Fish were unable to provide any suspect information at this time.

The value of the two items taken is \$4,340.00.

I obtained a written statement from Mr. Turner and Mrs. Fish. A computer check was conducted of the incident area for suspicious activity within the time frame of the incident, which met with negative results. The victim was able to provide a serial number for the golf cart which was entered into NCIC by ECO Shuman (6463). There was no sign of forced entry to the building and it appeared that the unknown suspect(s) used a key.

This case transferred to GIS.
