The substantial completion set in Change Order No. 11 is incorrect. The correct date of substantial completion is the 20 July 2005.

The request for substantial completion inspection came on 20 July 2005 and the actual inspection was performed on 26 July 2005 solely due to conflicts in my schedule and that of the engineers. The contractor's request for inspection stopped the construction time clock on the 20th, and the subsequent inspection confirmed that they were substantially complete.

In order to avoid levying liquidated damages for the delay in inspection, the substantial completion date must be revised to 20 July 2005.
