On this date at approximately 0720 hours, I responded to 215 Corona Dr. at S. Bryan Jennings Elementary School in reference to a burglary. Upon my arrival, contact was made with Norman Dean, employee and reporting party. Dean stated he was advised by numerous employees of the school that items were missing from the school and that several doors have been forced open.

At this time I observed the door at the east side of the media center. The door had been pried open, near the handle area. Once inside the suspect(s) removed two plexi-glass panel in two separate interior doors, in order to gain entry inside the other rooms of the media center. The suspect(s) then removed two Hitachi projectors and a digital camera from the media room. The suspect(s) then removed a computer/CPU from the library area, leaving all power cords behind.

The suspect(s) also entered portable building #77, which is the music class, where they removed a computer/CPU and laptop computer. The CPU and laptop computer were left on the outside porch at the south side of the portable #77. The suspect(s) then entered portable #43 where a Hitachi projector was removed. Both portables showed signs of having the doors pried open with an unknown prying tool.

The Suspect(s) also entered the maintenance storage building by prying open the door. Once inside the suspect(s) discharged a fire extinguisher inside of the building, leaving the discharged extinguisher sitting on a lawn mower.

Contact was also made with teacher, Geralynn Henderson who stated that when she left the school at 1730 hours she observed a white male on a bicycle riding around the buildings at the school. Deborah Boley, teacher and involved other stated she left the school at 2015 hours she observed three white males, approximately 12-14 years of age in the parking lot. Boley advised she recognized one of the boys as, Bradley Moody, a former student.

Sgt Chalker #721 was notified of this incident and was present on the scene.

Detective Rospiler #7142 arrived on the scene and assumed the investigation.

Deputy Gadt #6183 arrived on the scene and processed the area for usable evidence.

All electronic equipment with a serial number was entered in NCIC/FCIC by ECO Wertz #6190.
