On this date I responded to 215 Corona Drive in reference to a burglary.

Upon arrival I made contact with the Vice Principal Tiffany Outman who stated someone broke several windows throughout the school campus. T. Outman showed me windows that were broken out of building numbers 11, 78, 75, 34, 28B, and the media center.

During my investigation, I found that someone broke the windows in the buildings to gain entry into them. The media center had the glass window in the door broken, so they could pull the door handle from the inside. The media center was missing two laptops, two camcorders, a digital projector, and six cameras.

They also broke into the following buildings:

Portable 78 - C. Hills classroom

Portable 75 - J. Pansell's classroom

Portable 34 - C. Sease's classroom

Portable 28B - Literacy Lab

It is unknown if they took anything at this time from the above portables because the teachers are not working today.

They also broke the bathroom windows in building 11B and Building 9, but it did not appear they made entry into those rooms.

CST Hearth arrived, photographed, and processed the scene for evidence. While walking with CST Hearth, I made contact with Ken Wilson from 357 Dillon Drive (618-534-3424) who stated he found a baseball bat on the basketball court. K. Wilson stated he took the bat home. I asked K. Wilson to retrieve the bat so it could be processed for evidence.

We also found two boom box radios underneath portable 75. T. Outman stated they belong to the school but doesn't remember what teacher had them last.

I was unable to conduct a canvass because there are no houses that could see where the crimes occurred.

The stolen items were entered into NCIC/FCIC by ECO Saunders # 5028
