Dear Chairman Studdard,

The purpose of this letter is an effort to clarify our roles in setting school board meeting agendas. Our current board policy states the superintendent shall establish the agenda for the school board meetings in consultation with the board chairman. Over the past year and a half, I believe you and I have done a good job implementing this policy. However, most recently, I am disturbed by the events of last month's meeting including our consultation meeting when you directed me to deny a scheduled citizen's request to speak. When I did not remove that item from the agenda, you unilaterally denied the citizen's request to speak without a vote or consensus from the board.

First, as your executive officer, it is my job to develop the agenda as well as advise and counsel the school board. Although the policy states that I will consult with the board chair, it does not give the board chair approval/veto power over items I recommend to be placed on the agenda. The board, at their meeting, can then vote items up or down. This process ensures a separation of power.

Second, it is my responsibility to ensure that the school board is meeting the requirements of Policy 1.02 as well as all other policies in the day to day operations of the school district. The scheduled citizen request that you denied, in my opinion, met the requirements of our policy. In fact, this citizen even asked you if further details were needed. You chose not to respond to him and you also made disparaging remarks to my secretary and me regarding this individual to the effect of, "I'm over him, I'm tired of him, and I'm not going to deal with him anymore." In addition, your actions were inconsistent with your past practice of what was allowed for a scheduled citizen's request. I have included, for your review, a list of previous speakers and their level of detail. As your superintendent, Florida Statute compels me to advise you that I believe your action in the denial of the citizen's request in April constitutes a violation of the policy and ultimately places this school district at risk for possible litigation. I have attached for your review copies of PowerPoint slides from a training in which we both participated. These slides speak to my concerns.

If it is your desire to develop a revision to Policy 1.02 to restrict a citizen's speech based on time rather than content (other than profane or disruptive) I stand ready to assist and work with you. I suggest we schedule a workshop after this school year ends to work together on these issues.

I hope you find this information helpful. I am available to meet with you to discuss this further.
