The reading/intervention coach is responsible directly to the principal and supervisor of Reading/LA/RtI/VPK for managing reading instruction as specified in the District K-12 Reading Plan. The reading/intervention coach will be a mentor and staff development facilitator.

Responsibilities and Duties of this Position Include:

- 1. Assist the classroom teacher in establishing a literacy-rich classroom environment.
- 2. Demonstrate knowledge of assessments, the core reading program, guided reading practices, and all supplemental and remediation programs as specified in the District K-12 Reading Plan.
- 3. Attend coaching institutes and other training opportunities, including monthly reading/intervention coach meeting.
- 4. Model effective reading instruction and/or interventions at each grade level.
- 5. Collaborate with reading intervention teachers in implementing the core reading program.

- 8. Assist in identifying professional development needs.
- 9. Monitor student progress and collaborate with teachers in providing differentiated instruction.
- 10. Assist content area teachers in implementing appropriate reading strategies as needed.
- 11. Facilitate teachers in the CAR-PD process.
- 12. Serve as a liaison between schools and the district-level RtI team and reading administrative staff.
- 13. Provide training and technical assistance to school-based leadership teams to implement the PS/RtI Model and the K-12 Reading Plan.

Is responsible for developing and implementing data security systems that will provide detection, prevention, and containment and deterrence mechanisms to protect and maintain the integrity of data files throughout the school district. Is responsible for ensuring that our users have access to only educationally relevant Internet sites.

Responsibilities and duties of this position include:

- 1. Develops and maintains policies, procedures and standards that are designed to protect computer programs, data bases and data files from unauthorized or accidental duplication, modification, or destruction.
- 2. Establishes and maintains correct access rules defining who had permissions to which data sets and under what circumstances. These rules will be maintained in servers, routers, fire walls, filters and applications.
- 3. Refines and implements the current data security plan according to established time lines.
- 4. Presents information to management and makes recommendations for technical security architecture changes and resources (e.g., hardware, software and telecommunication equipment) to ensure equipment/software meets current and future requirements.
- 5. Provides technical and functional leadership on complex projects.
- 6. Works with departments and schools to solve security problems with available technologies.
- 7. Maintains controls to limit virus exposure and regularly scans critical IT assets for the existence of new virus threats. Develops procedures to ensure that all desktops, servers and network devices have the latest virus definitions and system updates.
- 8. Creates, develops and maintains a security awareness program that provides communication on security best practices and the effect they have on the school district.
- 9. Monitors/subscribes to alerting services that provide up to the minute advisories on potential threats. Analyzes the applicability and risk associated with each of the advisories based on the IT infrastructure.
- 10. Performs self-assessments to validate that all the latest security patches have been applied and all systems have been security hardened with the minimal services required to perform the necessary functionality.
- 11. Develops procedures to quickly recover damaged files/servers in the event of a malicious or inadvertent attack.
- 12. Develops a regularly scheduled security reporting system that identifies breaches and documents the current security environment.
