

RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION OF THE SCHOOL BOARD OF CLAY COUNTY, FLORIDA, FINDING THAT HISTORICALLY THE OFFICE OF DISTRICT SCHOOL SUPERINTENDENT HAS BEEN FILLED BY ELECTION BY THE CITIZENS OF THE COUNTY, FINDING THAT THIS MEANS OF SELECTION HAS PROVIDED THE COUNTY SCHOOL SYSTEM WITH QUALITY LEADERSHIP, HAS PROVIDED THE CITIZENS OF CLAY COUNTY WITH THE OPPORTUNITY TO PARTICIPATE IN GOVERNMENT BY CHOOSING THE DISTRICT SCHOOL SUPERINTENDENT, AND FINDING THAT SOLIDARITY AMONG THE SCHOOL BOARD MEMBERS AND THEIR SUPPORT OF THE SUPERINTENDENT WOULD BE SERVED BY THIS RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF CONTINUATION OF ELECTION BY THE CITIZENS OF CLAY COUNTY AS THE MEANS OF CHOOSING THE DISTRICT SCHOOL SUPERINTENDENT.

WHEREAS, throughout the history of Clay County the District School Superintendent has been a position filled by the citizens of the county by election, and

WHEREAS, this method of selection has worked well throughout history by providing the citizens of the county with the opportunity to participate in the selection of those who will govern, and

WHEREAS, throughout history this method of selection has resulted in quality leadership for the office of District School Superintendent, and

WHEREAS, it is important at this time to show solidarity among the School Board members and support of the current Superintendent of Schools by declaring support of the process of election of the office of District School Superintendent,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by The School Board of Clay County, Florida, that it affirms its unanimous support of the continuation of the use of election by the citizens of Clay County as the means by which the District Superintendent of Schools is chosen.
