Background

- On waiting list for Navy JROTC for over a decade
- Loss of “A” status and school recognition funds (\$130,000)
- Stabilize, encourage “at – risk” students
- Student body surveyed
- 77 college and career bound students committed to program



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Why Army, not Navy?

- Navy not expanding
- Conversation with Navy suggested Army was expanding programs
- Army JROTC /NDCC process very flexible and accommodating as compared to Navy



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Instructor Qualifications

- **Must be retired and certified by Cadet Command to teach JROTC whether the program is JROTC or NDCC**
- **JROTC / NDCC instructors are “double vetted” once by Cadet Command then by CCSD in a very structured selection process**
