HP Grant Executive Summary  
February 2009

The Clay County School District plans to use the HP Innovations in Education Grant for an **Engineering for All** program that will affect pre-engineering students at a high school, students from a feeder junior high school, and elementary students from two feeder schools. The grant funds and equipment will be used to start a rigorous pre-engineering curriculum that supports the Science, Technology, Engineering and Math (STEM) initiatives in education. There will be an integration of academics and career education that will prepare high school students for industry certifications and postsecondary education.

The equipment and funds will be used to upgrade an Orange Park High (OPHS) program to an Engineering and Design Academy that will support the Project Lead the Way (PLTW) pre-engineering curriculum. Lakeside Junior High School (LSJ) will also be a grant recipient to upgrade hardware and professional development in order to prepare students for success in the OPHS pre-engineering program and for the PLTW curriculum. The school district will commit funding to purchase the PLTW curriculum for OPHS and LSJ. OPHS pre-engineering students and their mentors will visit LSJ and feeder elementary schools to facilitate students' understanding of the STEM curriculum.
