WEB-BASED SYSTEM FOR HIGH SCHOOL MAJOR AREAS OF

INTEREST

As you are aware, beginning with students entering high school in the 2007-2008 school year, graduation requirements include enrollment in a major area of interest, comprised of four (4) credits (Section 1003.428, Florida Statutes). Proposed major areas of interest shall be annually approved by the district school board and submitted to the Commissioner of Education by October 1. The statute further provides that "[e]ach major area of interest shall be deemed approved unless specifically rejected by the commissioner within 60 days. Upon approval, each district's major areas of interest shall be available for use by all school districts and shall be posted on the department's website."

In order to facilitate this process, the Department of Education has created a Web-based system for district school boards to submit their major areas of interest for approval. Additionally, in order to simplify the selection of some major areas of interest, the Commissioner has already approved those that involve a single content area, as determined by the Course Code Directory, within specific academic and career and technical education areas.

Input Steps

The Web-based system to enter high school major areas of interest is now available at http://public2.fldoe.org/HSMajors/login.aspx. Here is an overview of the system:

1. Logging On: After clicking on the link to this Web site, a username and password will be requested. The username is the name of the school district and the initial password is the district two-digit number. Immediately after typing in the two-digit number and submitting, the system will request that you change your password. This new password will only be available to the district. It is important that all district staff charged with submitting information know the password.

2. Contact Information Section: Each district must have a contact person for implementation of high school major areas of interest. This person will be contacted if there are any questions regarding any of the information provided through this Web-based system.

- 3. State Approved Major Areas of Interest for High Schools Section: The major areas of interest that are already state approved, are predominantly those that involve only one academic or career and technical education area. All schools must submit at least two major areas of interest, including one for students with disabilities working toward a special diploma. If a school in your district serves students an average of less than one year (such as a DJJ program), please submit the ESE (special diploma) state approved major area of interest and one general area that can be offered in the elective area. Every high school listed must have submitted major areas of interest to get to the logout page for district final submission.
 - 4. Proposed Integrated Major Areas of Interest Section: Districts and schools that desire to create major areas of interest that are not on the State Approved Major Areas of Interest list will do so by selecting the courses that will comprise the major area of interest in this section. For each proposal, a brief survey must also be completed to provide the DOE with more information. All proposed major areas of interest will be considered DRAFT until October 1, at which point the 60-day approval period will begin.
 - 5. Notify DOE That Your Data Entry is Complete Section: By completing this page with the Superintendent's approval assurance, the DOE will know that your information is complete.

Featured on this system are also links to the technical assistance documents that have previously been distributed on these high school related requirements.

This memorandum contains two attachments. One is a document that contains an overview on proposing major areas of interest, including the survey questions and the questions that DOE reviewers will consider in making recommendations to the Commissioner for each proposal. The second is a list of all of the approved major areas of interest.

Thank you for your questions and enthusiasm on implementing secondary reform. We have received numerous calls, questions, and feedback from you and your staff that exemplify how you have embraced these initiatives.
