On 8/15/2007 while at Orange Park High School, I was advised by Assistant Principal, Bill Fletcher (RP) that two new Dell computers were stolen from Joseph Wiltsie's classroom (RM

I spoke to B. Fletcher who is in charge of property for OPHS. He provided me with the serial numbers and value of the merchandise stolen.

I spoke to Teacher, Joseph Wiltsie (IO) who told me that on an unknown day during the summer he was told by CCSB CTE Director, Paul Parker (IO) that the seven computers, seven monitors, and seven sets of speakers that were in the janitor's storage closet (RM 132) were going to be for his class room. He also told me that he was told to move those computers to his classroom by P. Parker. He said he moved all seven computers, monitors, and seven sets of speakers to the rear of his classroom on an unknown date. On July 26th or 27th J. Wiltsie said he was at the school for a meeting. He said when he left at the end of the day he locked his classroom and saw that all seven sets of the merchandise were there.

J. Wiltsie told me that when he returned to OPHS on August 13, 2007, he moved seven monitors, seven sets of speakers, and only five computers to his storage closet inside his classroom. He said it wasn't till Assistant Principal, Mike Elia came looking for the computers that "it occurred to him" that two computers were missing. He said he does teach night classes, but he never leaves the classroom while the students are there. J. Wiltsie said several times when he came to the school to work on his room he has noticed that the door to his class room has been unlocked.

I contacted CTE Director, P. Parker via the telephone at the CCSD office and asked him if he directed J. Wiltsie to move the computers from the storage room to the classroom. P. Parker told me at no point did he tell J. Wiltsie to move any computers. He did tell J. Wiltsie that the seven computers that were in the storage room were going to be for his classroom. P. Parker told me that himself along with J. Wiltsie and two administrators had a meeting prior in reference to the moving of the computers and he told J. Wiltsie that he never told him to move the computers.

Upon investigating, a statement was completed, sworn to, and signed by J. Wiltsie on scene. I went to J. Wiltsie's classroom and could find no signs of forced entry. I located five computers that were still in there box inside the storage closet where he had said he had moved them previously. There is presently no suspect information.

This case is transferred to JCU Detective Rosepiler. This is an active and pending case.
