

Executive Summary

Title: District Digital Classroom Plan

FDOE Bureau/Office: Division of Technology and Information Services, Bureau of Educational Technology

Funding Authority: A DCP allocation has been established to assist districts in this effort under s. 1011.62(12)(c), F.S.

Amount: \$531,603

Purpose: The intent of the District Digital Classroom Plan (DCP) is to provide a perspective on what the district considers being vital and critically important in relation digital learning implementation, the improvement of student performance outcomes, and how this progress will be measured. The plan shall meet the unique needs of students, schools and personnel in the district as required by s.1011.62(12)(b), F.S.

Plan: The SDCC DCP will address the five key components as required by s.1011.62(12)(b), F.S. The District will outline specific deliverables that will be implemented in the current year that are funded from the DCP Allocation. The five components that are included are:

- A) Student Performance Outcomes
- B) Digital Learning and Technology Infrastructure
- C) Professional Development
- D) Digital Tools
- E) Online Assessments

The School District of Clay County will apply for funds totaling \$531,603 for the following:

- Upgrade network infrastructure
- Increase bandwidth
- Expand wireless coverage
- Expansion of Digital Tools (CAPE Certifications)

* The DCP must be submitted to the department for approval by October 1, 2014.
